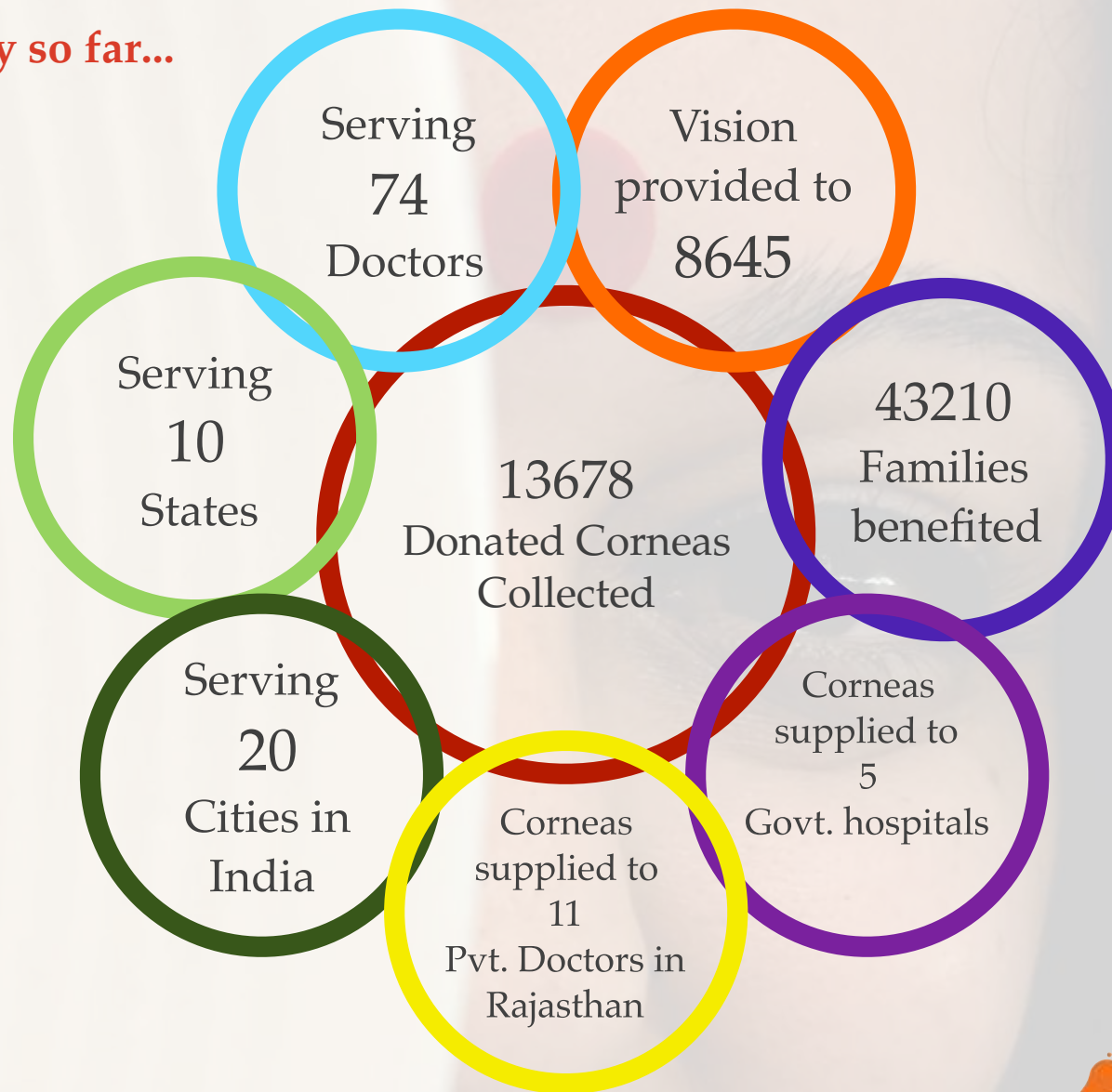

Dear Friends,

It is a pleasure to share with you the Annual Performance Report of the Eye Bank Society of Rajasthan. This report covers the period of two years 2018 and 2019. Two AGMs were held in 2018, so that AGM could be held within stipulated time.

During 2018, 1221 corneas were collected & 876 were transplanted at 72% utilisation rate. HCRP contributed 80%, against 20% from voluntary calls. Out of this Jaipur contributed 56% and Ajmer 18%.

EBSR had a roller coaster journey in 2019. The performance was incredible and new milestones were achieved. The annual goal of transplanting 950 corneas was achieved in just a little more than 7 months. For the first time mark of 1000 corneas was crossed. We registered 65% growth, highest in India.

More than 100 corneas in a month were transplanted for 10 months continuously. We even crossed the mark of 150 corneas in a month, standing Second amongst all eye banks in India. It is remarkable!

EBSR registered an all round growth on almost all fronts like cornea collection, transplant, utilisation, notification and distribution. In 2019 we received 2179 donated corneas and restored vision of 1437 people, which is highest ever. EDC productivity increased to 9.5 corneas per month.

In view of rising aspirations of people it has become imperative to improve existing facilities and plan for future growth. Therefore, it has been decided to construct a new building of EBSR in Calvary Charitable Eye Hospital campus for which an MOU has been signed.

The new campus will have facilities of processing, training, research, Keratoplasty, meetings, workshops etc.

Awareness fortnight was observed with great enthusiasm. Hon'ble Health Minister, Dr. Raghu Sharma gave away awards for outstanding contribution to our cause. He promised to train more surgeons for Keratoplasty so that more and more corneal blinds of Rajasthan get benefitted.

The material for this report includes matter from report of the President and Secretary to the AGM. The financial results and statement of accounts have been contributed by Treasurer and Mr. Santosh, Ms. Sudershana Shekhawat, Manager EBSR has helped with draft and photographs of the report. Ms. Deeksha Sharma of Myra Films agency, helped with designing and editing the report. Mr. Laxman Bolia gave valuable suggestions regarding lay out and printing. I am grateful to all of them for their support and contribution.

I hope team EBSR will continue the present level of performance to carve out a place in the eye banking community of India.

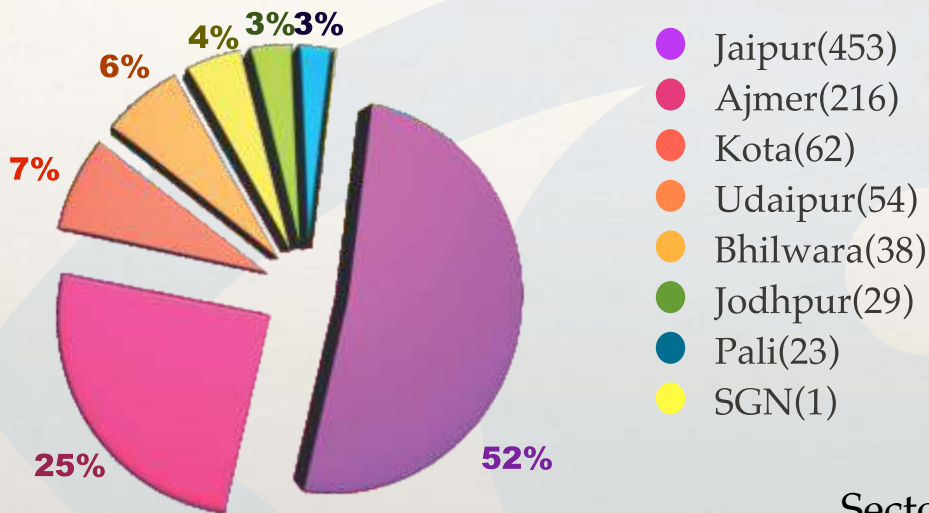

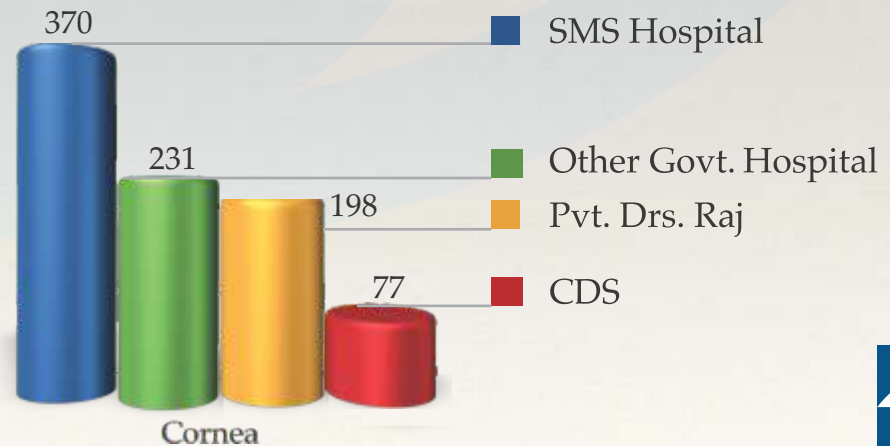


Cornea Distribution Year 2018

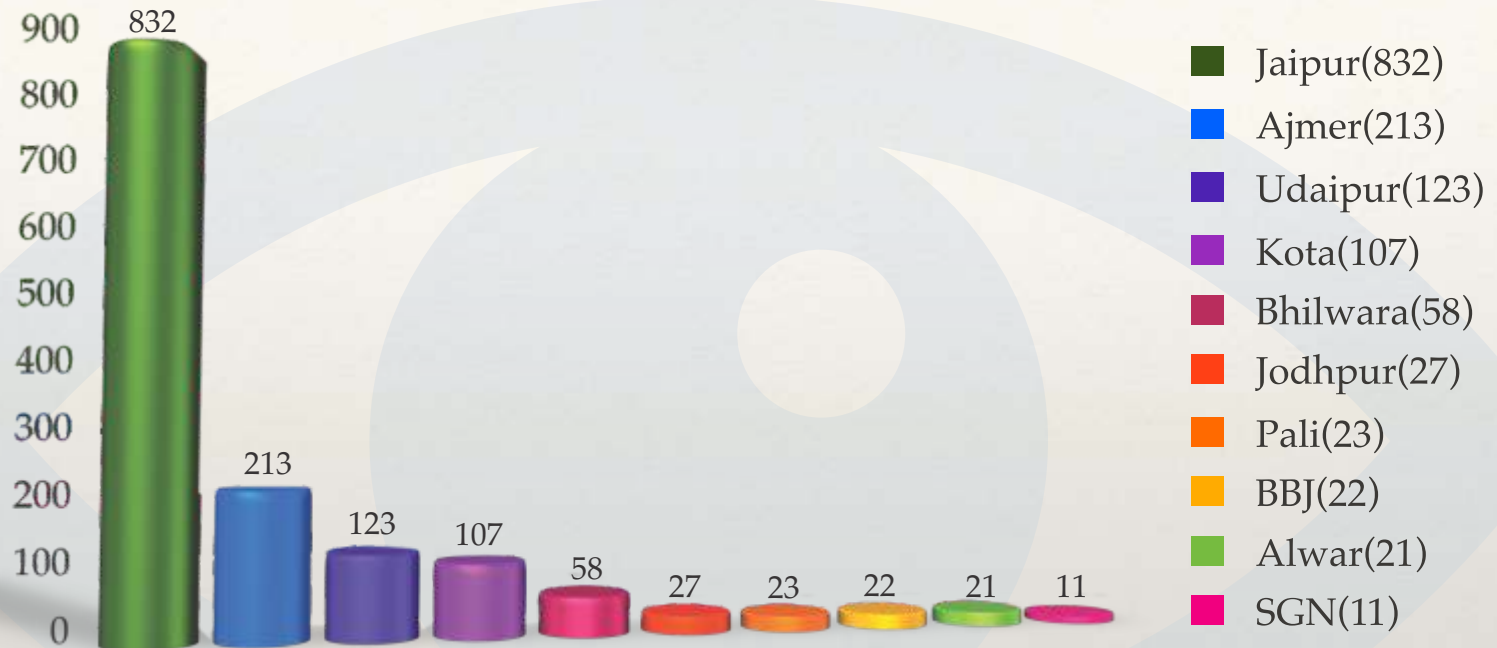

- ❖ During the closing function at Central Park, Jaipur, trees were planted in the memory of donors and good performers along with honouring the donors.

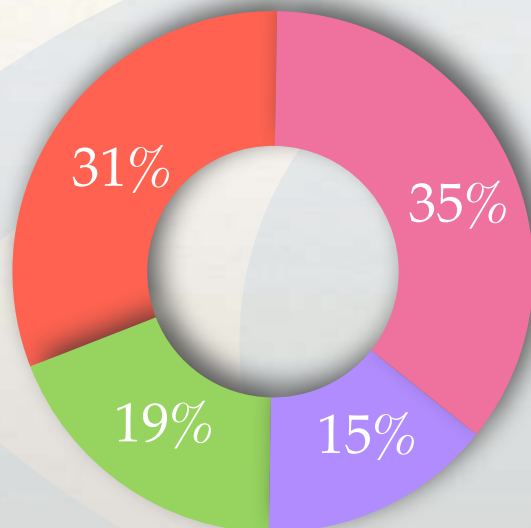

Transplanting corneas in the year 2019

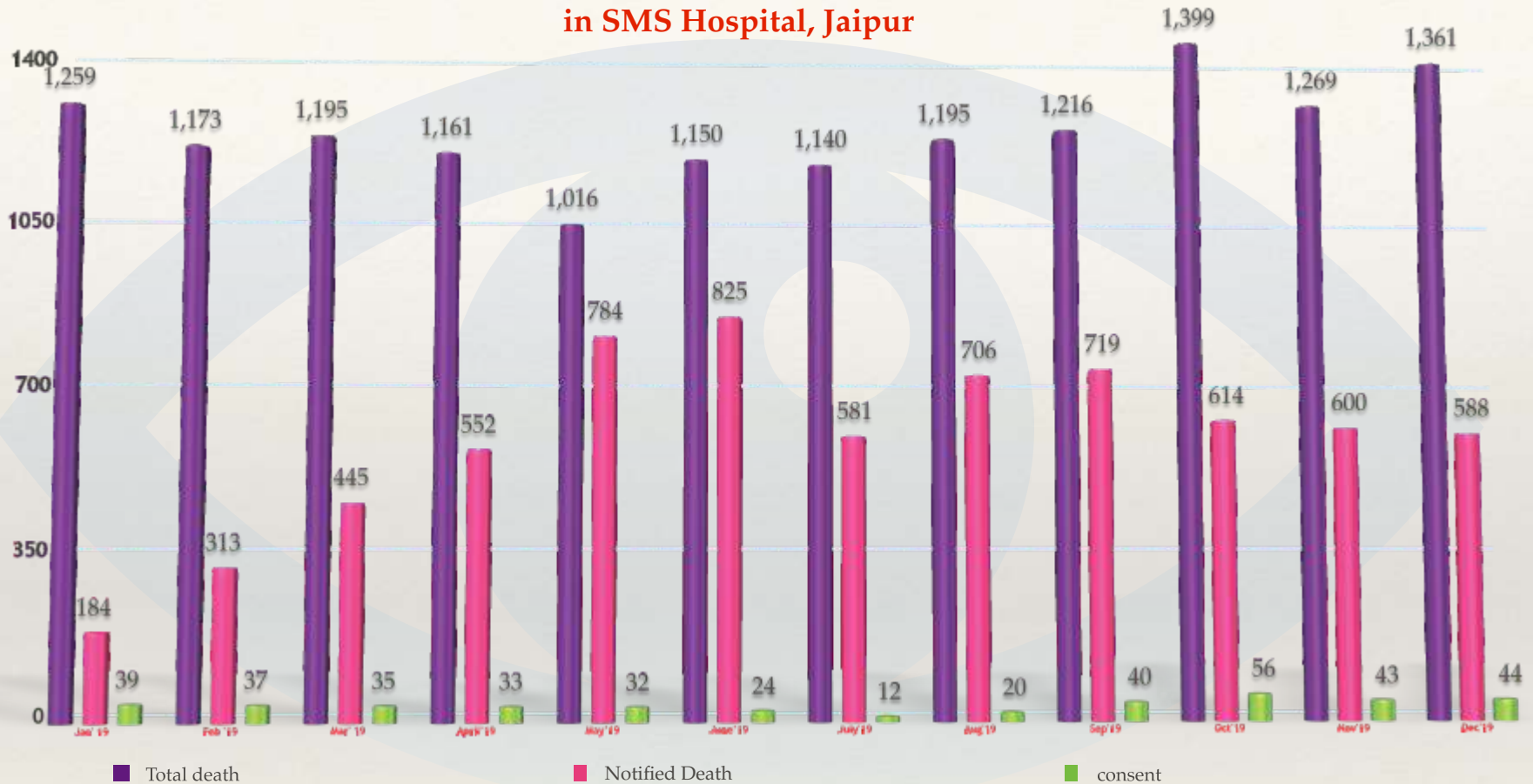

It is our prime concern to see that maximum corneas are utilised in Rajasthan. Therefore, about 69% corneas were distributed to doctors in Rajasthan during 2019. Remaining 31% corneas were sent out of Rajasthan so as to utilise the donated cornea. Out of this 50% were given to Government Hospitals free of charge for transplanting on poor and needy persons. EBSR is supplying corneas to 20 cities in 10 states of India. It is possible to utilise all cornea in Rajasthan to meet the local demand if more surgeons in government and private hospitals perform cornea transplant surgery.

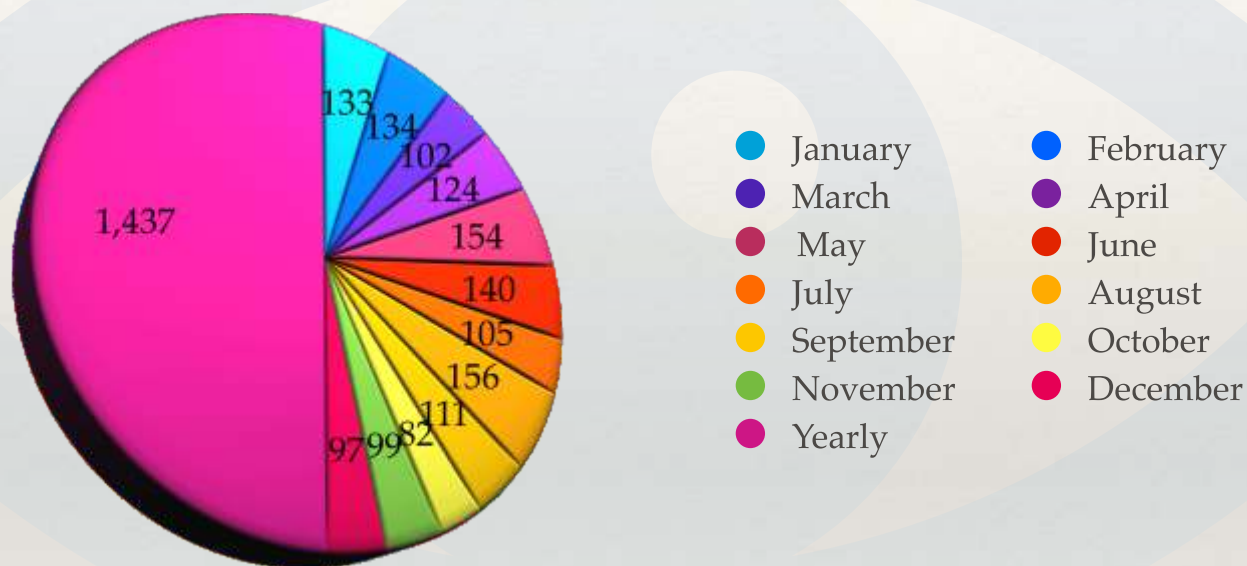

Most notable feature of the year 2019 has been remarkable improvement in employee productivity. In 2018 productivity of EDCs was 6.3 cornea per person. Whereas in the year 2019 it has jumped to 9.3 corneas p/p. This is almost at par with National average. Other 3 EDCs have registered productivity of 13 to 22 corneas.

Ms. Sudershana Shekhawat, Manager, EBSR, has been instrumental in driving team for stellar growth in 2019. She took it as a challenge to see that EBSR attains the podium position with unbelievable performance. She brought professionalism in eye bank working that helped in establishing new work ethics. Sudershana displayed remarkable zeal in establishing the first ever training facility in EBSR. Training of counsellor and technicians was coordinated by her resulting in 13 persons being trained in 2019 with good results.



The role of supervisory staff has always been crucial. Mr Ram Dayal AM (Devp.) has been constantly working in SMS Hospital Jaipur to improve contacts with hospital staff to enhance notification . As a result, notification rate jumped from 15% to 44% and consent rate increased from 39% to 56% during this year, which is a great achievement. His presence and guidance improved staff performance .

EBSR Training Institute



- ❖ So far we were dependent on other Eye Banks for training.
- ❖ As we are now fully equipped, experienced & have resources, EBSR has started in house training from 1st Jan 2019.
- ❖ Initially Counsellor & Technicians training is being done for EBSR & Govt. of Rajasthan .
- ❖ It will be expanded in future.
- ❖ So far about 13 counsellor and technician have been trained as EDC/ technicians.
- ❖ Optometricians from Mahatma Gandhi Medical College Hospital, one each from Kota, Sikar and Bikaner Govt Hospitals have also been trained. Their performance is continuously monitored.

New Campus of EBSR



In order to meet rising aspirations of the deprived sections of the society & high hopes from EBSR, based on its past performance, it has become imperative for us to expand our activities. Therefore, it has been decided to construct a new building of EBSR in the campus of Calgary Charitable Eye Hospital, Malviya Nagar, Jaipur. This will enable EBSR to upgrade present level of functioning and add facilities of training, research, Keratoplasty, conference etc. It will be a unique model of collaboration between two charitable community based organisations working in the field of eye care. Thus, on 14th Sept 2019 EBSR and JCEH signed an MOU for constructing building of Eye Bank in the campus of Calgary eye hospital. It will help to fulfil objectives of both the organisations.

This eye bank has adopted e-hospital software used at KGMU for death notification, which gives instant information of death to EDC posted in hospital for quick retrieval.

Audited Accounts

Audited Accounts for F.Y 2017-2018

During FY 2017-18 Corpus fund increased by Rs 16,91,478/- to Rs 1,28,44,064/- Gross receipts were Rs 66,81,291/- which were lower by Rs 20,40,678 compared to last year's receipts due to more supply of free corneas to Govt. Hospitals. Further, Sight life has contributed Rs 2,77,726/- as compared to last year's contribution of Rs 4,93,113/-. This year also we received Rs 30 Lacs of donation from RSMML on account of CSR. This year total donation of Rs 10,99,376/- from individuals and private institutions/trusts was received as compared to Rs 6,84,756/- during last F.Y. Expenditure during this year was Rs.63,34,420/- which is commensurate to cornea retrieval and allied activities.

Audited Books of Accounts for FY 2018-19

In FY 2018-19 corpus fund is Rs 1,42,31,244/- indicating increase of Rs 13,87,180/- over last year. The higher income & Expenditure amount are due to increase in procuring record number of Corneas 1454, & 1069 transplantable corneas. Total receipts are Rs 86,23,657 an increase of Rs 19,42,366/- This is through processing fee, Grant in Aid from Govt. and higher donation of Rs 10,14,022/- over last year. A donation of Rs 30 Lakhs, under CSR from RSMML Foundation was received. This F.Y expenses were of Rs 75,81,477/- including Capital expenditure of Rs 4,07,440/- on installing a Solar Power Plant. The salary & wages payment have increased by Rs 5,58,541/. Important point to note is that productivity per staff has increased from 40.77 transplantable corneas to 56.26.

Proposed Budget for F.Y 2019-2020

In F.Y 2019-20 budget has been projected on the basis of 2000 cornea collection & 1300 transplantable Corneas, Staff strength has been maintained at present level of 19 members. Aggregate Receipts are projected at Rs 1,15,36,000/-. Usual pattern of distribution of corneas to Govt. Hospitals & Private hospitals has been maintained. Govt. Grant in Aid is projected in proportion to the agreed pattern of distribution. Sight Life contribution is as per MOU. Interest income is as per fixed deposits in bank. CSR donation of Rs 20 lakhs from RVPN has been received. Other donation is projected at a level of Rs. 15 lakhs.

Total Expenses are kept at Rs 97,48,000/- which are higher by Rs 21,66,523/- from last year's level. Item wise allied expenses have been arrived at based on revision of salary, new incentive & bonus scheme to staff, increased expenses on account of equipments etc.

Facts about Eye Donation

Corneal blindness

When cornea becomes opaque or is damaged, causing loss of vision, that is known as corneal blindness.

Corneal transplantation

By a surgical procedure damaged cornea is replaced with a healthy cornea to restore vision.

Who can be an eye donor?

A person from the age of 2-80 years can be a donor. Persons with certain diseases like HIV, Septicaemia, STD etc. cannot donate.

How soon the cornea be removed after death?

The cornea should be removed within 6-8 hours of death.

Will eye donation cause any disfigurement?

- ❖ No disfigurement is caused

Can a cataract or spectacle user donate?

- ❖ Yes. Both these conditions relate to the lens of the eye and not the cornea.

How can one help in Eye Donation?
