
President's Message

T t is with immense pride and profound gratitude that I present the Annual Performance Report of the Eye Bank ■ Society of Rajasthan (EBSR) for the years 2023 and 2024. This period has been nothing sort of extraordinary—a testament to the power of compassion, collaboration, and an unwavering belief in the possibility of a brighter tomorrow. As I reflect on our journey, I am humbled by the sheer magnitude of hope and humility that defines EBSR. The recognition of EBSR as an empanelled Eye Bank of Rajasthan is not merely a milestone; it is a celebration of the countless individuals who have come together to create a legacy of light. For 23 years, we have been more than an organization—we have been a beacon of hope, a catalyst for change, and a family united by the shared dream of transforming lives through the gift of sight. In the years 2023 & 2024, we achieved something truly remarkable. We collected 5,698corneas and facilitated 3,668 life-changing corneal transplants, bringing happiness into the lives of over 14,676 family members. Each of these numbers represents a story—a child seeing mother for the first time, an elder regaining the ability to witness the world's beauty, and a family finding joy in the restored vision of their loved one. Moreover, 50% of the corneas were provided free of charge to the government hospitals, ensuring that even the most vulnerable among us could access this precious gift. Our impact extends far and wide in Rajasthan as well as in India. We have 14 chapters in all key districts, including Jaipur, Udaipur, Kota, Bikaner, and Sri Ganganagar and through them we cover in all 22 districts of Rajasthan. EBSR provides 97% of cornea distributed in Rajasthan. We stand as a pillar of excellence and accessibility. Our partnerships

with 23 private hospitals in Rajasthan and with over 30 hospitals in 10 States amplifies our reach, ensuring that every transplant is not just a medical procedure but a lifeline of hope. The credit for these achievements goes to the countless faces and stories that inspire us to do more. The tearful joy of a mother whose child can now read, the gratitude of an elderly who can see the sunrise again, and the determination of families who choose to donate, despite their own grief—these are the moments that define our success. Our state-of-the-art training institute continues to nurture dedicated professionals, ensuring that the light we bring today will shine brightly into the future. Meanwhile, our mobile outreach programs and awareness campaigns are sowing seeds of understanding and compassion, particularly in underserved rural communities. None of this would have been possible without the unwavering support of our CSR partners, especially RSMML, RIICO, State Bank of India, whose contributions have been a lifeline to our mission. 




Sector Wise Distribution -2023

Our EDCT Training programs have been instrumental in enhancing the skills of our technicians and supervisory staff. In 2023, we trained 06 technicians and 03 Assistant Managers, while in 2024, we expanded our reach to 13 technicians and 02 supervisory staff. Through these training sessions, we equipped our teams with expertise in cornea retrieval and counseling, as well as chapter supervision and awareness creation for eye donation. As a result, we've been able to extend our services to rural areas, leading to a significant increase in cornea collection and bringing us closer to our mission of promoting eye donation and sight restoration.

Employee Welfare - Caring and Empowering The Work Force

Employee Welfare Initiatives at EBSR

At the Eye Bank Society of Rajasthan (EBSR), we prioritize creating a supportive and caring work environment. Our key welfare initiatives include:

- ⇒ **Provident Fund:** Both employees and EBSR contribute 12% of the salary for staff earning up to ₹15,000/month, ensuring financial security.
- ⇒ **Gratuity:** Employees with 5+ years of service receive gratuity equal to 15 days' salary per year, based on current pay on resignation or retirement.
- ⇒ **Accident Insurance:** Comprehensive ₹ 20 lakh coverage for accidental death or permanent disability, with a ₹14,000 annual premium paid by EBSR.
- ⇒ **Medical Reimbursement:** Premium reimbursed for health Insurance of employees not covered under ESI, prioritizing health and well-being.
- ⇒ **Additional Increments:** Exceptional performance rewarded with extra increments to recognize dedication.
- ⇒ **Out-of-Turn Promotion:** Fast-track promotions for consistent excellence and outstanding achievements.
- ⇒ **Retention Bonus:** ₹ 2,500 bonus for completing one year of service as a token of appreciation.





The Slit Lamp Microscope is an essential instrument for corneal evaluation, offering detailed imaging that enhances EBSR's ability to assess corneal health with greater accuracy and efficiency. This advancement will improve access to high-quality transplantable corneas, bringing renewed hope to countless individuals affected by corneal blindness.

Financials



Audited Accounts for the Financial Year 2023-24

- (a) Trust funds of the Society increased to Rs. 3,51,20,648/-, an increase of Rs 1,07,60,624/- over last year.
- **(b)** Corpus fund increased to Rs. 1, 64, 70,931/-, and addition of Rs. 33, 33,211/ over last year.
- (c) Total receipts of EBSR are Rs. 2, 75, 74,583/- showing an increase of Rs. 72, 91,877/-over last year. This is attributed to increase in processing fee and higher donations over last year's level. The Society received AAPI Grant Rs. 29.32 lakhs and grants under CSR Scheme from SBI of Rs. 33 lakhs ,RSMML of Rs 30 Lakhs, RICO Rs. 15 lakhs and Rs. 0.50 lakhs from Mava Gems Pvt. Ltd. Grant In Aid from the state government of Rs. 54.32 Lakhs for the period Sept 2021 to Sept 2023.
- (d) Total expenses increased to Rs. 1, 68, 13,958/- which are higher by Rs. 32, 25,905/ over last year due to an increase in salary, higher cornea collections requiring more consumables supplies and organization of more awareness activities. New items like donor's felicitation and software for digitisation of cornea management also added to the cost.

Audited Accounts for the Financial Year 2022-23

The Trust Fund of the Society has grown by Rs. 66,94,653, reaching Rs. 2,43,60,024, while the Corpus Fund increased by Rs. 4,23,111 to Rs.1,31,37,720. Total receipts for the year amounted to Rs. 2,02,82,706, including Rs. 5,30,293 from Chapters, reflecting a significant rise of Rs.1,03,41,033 over the previous year. This increase is attributed to a higher processing fee of Rs. 48,38,600, increased donations amounting to Rs. 21,12,287, and major grants, including Rs. 24.99 lakhs from AAPI, Rs. 21 lakhs from RSMM, Rs. 15 lakhs from RICO, and Rs. 5 lakhs from Sri Ram General Insurance. On the expenditure side, the total expenses rose by Rs. 42,59,700 to Rs. 1,35,88,253, primarily due to Rs.16,09,137 spent on additional medical supplies and equipment, Rs. 3,12,543 on awareness programs, and Rs. 4,68,670 on bonuses and incentives. New expenditures included Rs. 2,23,219 on a donor felicitation function, Rs. 2,45,204 on website redevelopment, and Rs. 4,85,304 on donor data analysis. Notably, salary payments decreased by Rs. 3,35,354 compared to the previous year.


